

Privacy Policy

Ploinks, Inc. ("us", "we", or "our") operates the Ploinks™ software applications and related services (collectively, the "Services").

This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information when you use our Services. We have a separate privacy policy for our Ploinks™ website (www.Ploinks.com) which you may find at: <http://www.Ploinks.com/Privacy-Policy-Website>.

We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy.

We use your Personal Information (which is defined below) for providing and improving the Services. By using the Services, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy. Unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy, terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meanings as in our Terms of Use concerning our Services which may be found at www.Ploinks.com/Terms-of-Use-Ploinks-Services.

Personal Information Collection and Use

While using our Services, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to, your email address, name, and phone number ("Personal Information"). We collect this information for the purpose of providing the Services, identifying and communicating with you, responding to your requests/inquiries, servicing your purchase orders (like through Google Play or another third party service provider that processes payments), and improving our Services.

Please see the section regarding Location Information below regarding the use of your location information and your options.

Personal Information We Do Not Collect or Use

Our Services allow you to display, link, store, share and otherwise make available certain information, text, graphics, videos, or other material ("Content") to other users of the Services. We do not collect any personal info related to Content you display or share with other Users or with such Content stored on your device when using our Services. In fact, we cannot collect personal information related to such Content you display or share with other Users or store on your device when using our Services because we do not have access to such Content.

You are responsible for the Content that you display or share using the Services, including its legality, reliability, and appropriateness.

Location Information

We may use and store information about your location depending on the permissions you have set on your device. We use this information to provide features of our Services, to improve and customize our Services. You can enable or disable location services when you use our Service at any time through your mobile device settings.

Third Party Behavioral Tracking

It's also important to note that we do not allow third-party behavioral tracking.

Service Providers

We may employ third party companies and individuals to facilitate our Services, to provide our Services on our behalf, to perform Service-related services and/or to assist us in analyzing how our Services is used.

These third parties have access to your Personal Information only to perform specific tasks on our behalf and are obligated not to disclose or use your information for any other purpose. As an example, our Ploinks™ software applications are services we make available on available on Google Play. Consequently, so information you provide to Google will be governed by Google's Terms of Use and Privacy Policy.

Communications

We may use your Personal Information to respond to you if you have contacted us directly.

Compliance with Laws

We will disclose your Personal Information where required to do so by law or subpoena or if we believe that such action is necessary to comply with the law and the reasonable requests of law enforcement or to protect the security or integrity of our Services. We may disclose your Personal Information if we determine that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect any person from death or serious bodily injury, prevent fraud or abuse of our Services or our users, or protect Ploinks, Inc.'s property rights.

Fair Information Practices

The Fair Information Practices Principles form the backbone of privacy law in the United States and the concepts they include have played a significant role in the development of data protection laws around the globe. Understanding the Fair Information Practice Principles and how they should be implemented is critical to comply with the various privacy laws that protect personal information.

In order to be in line with Fair Information Practices, should we learn a data breach has occurred, we will notify users via in-site notification within 7 business days.

Business Transaction

If Ploinks, Inc. is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, your Personal Information may be transferred as a business asset. In such cases, we will provide notice before your Personal Information is transferred and/or becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

Security

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, and we strive to implement and maintain reasonable, commercially acceptable security procedures and practices appropriate to the nature of the information we store, in order to protect it from unauthorized access, destruction, use, modification, or disclosure.

We do not use regular malware scanning. We do not use vulnerability scanning and/or scanning to PCI standards.

Your Personal Information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential. In addition, all sensitive information you supply is encrypted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology.

We do not ask for credit card numbers, since all payments are processed through a gateway provider (such as Google Play) and are not stored or processed by us.

However, please be aware that no method of transmission over the internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure and we are unable to guarantee the absolute security of the Personal Information we have collected from you.

California Online Privacy Protection Act

CalOPPA is the first state law in the nation to require any entity that owns or operates a commercial websites or online service to post a privacy policy.
